In the two years since its inception, the Education Collaborative at Ashesi has continued to see progress in collaboration across African higher education institutions; with **25 institutions** reached, **201 teachers, leaders** and other higher education stakeholders engaged, and **over 2600 students** directly impacted through the implementation of new techniques and strategies.
